OVERVIEW - PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The IB History and Theory of Knowledge (TOK) Teacher is responsible for delivering an IB curriculum that develops historical thinking, critical analysis, and a global perspective. The role includes guiding students through historical research and preparing them for IB assessments.
